Current Events

Silver Lake Terrace: The Contractor has completed the majority of the boulevard grading in preparation for turf establishment (in the form of seed) this week, week of September 28th, along with misc. project cleanup.

Future Events

32nd Avenue and Croft Drive: Replacement trees are scheduled to be installed the week of October 5th.

Silver Lake Terrace: The Contractor will complete remaining turf establishment (in the form of seed), replacement tree installation, remaining driveway restoration, and project clean up next week, week of October 5th. Please avoid parking on the road to allow the contractor access to the boulevard area.

Silver Lane Detour

Silver Lane has been re-opened to traffic with the detour signage scheduled to be removed today, October 2nd.

Driveway Replacement

If you are planning to replace your entire driveway along Silver Lake Terrace and have not received an email, please contact **Katie Koscielak** as soon as possible to coordinate reimbursement to you contractor. Bituminous paving along Silver Lake Terrace has been completed. Homeowners should plan to schedule their driveway replacement immediately, if possible.

The City will reimburse homeowners only for the portion of driveway that was removed in order to complete the street and utility construction. Once the resident's Contractor has completed the driveway replacement, please submit the invoice from the Contractor to Katie Koscielak as soon as it is received. The City will only make payment directly to the resident's Contractor.

Tips of the Week

- Please do not park vehicles on streets under construction
- Slow down and watch for uneven surfaces
- Stay alert! Watch for signs, equipment, and workers
- Please remind children to stay away from the construction site, equipment, and stockpiles of materials
- Access through the site may change throughout the day as construction progresses; your patience is appreciated
