Reimbursement will only be made at the unit price for the same pavement material of the existing driveway; therefore, charges for upgrading from an asphalt driveway to a concrete driveway are the responsibility of the homeowner. Upon completion of the work, your contractor should submit the bill to Katie Koscielak at KKoscielak@wsbeng.com for payment on the City's portion of the driveway replacement. The City portion of the bill will only be paid at the unit prices listed above and the remainder will be the responsibility of the homeowner.
